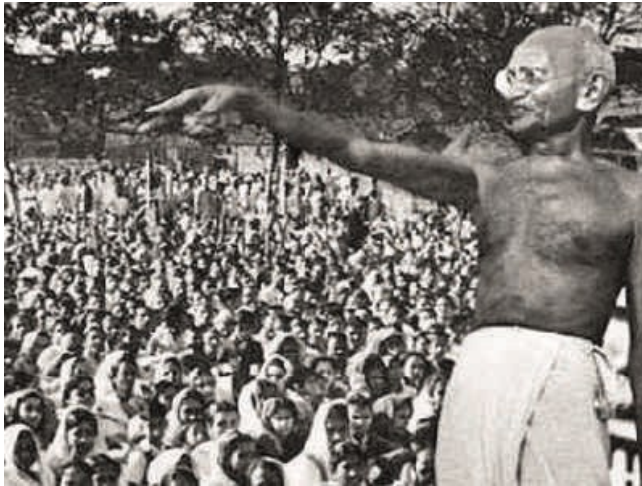

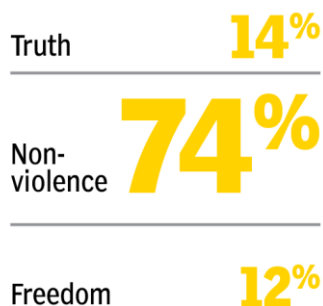
## Discovering the Mahatma in you

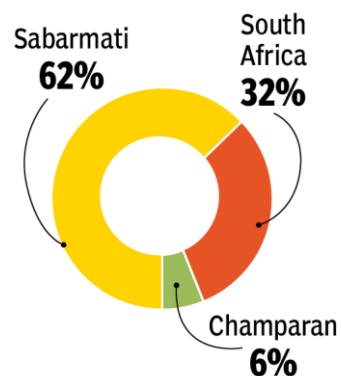

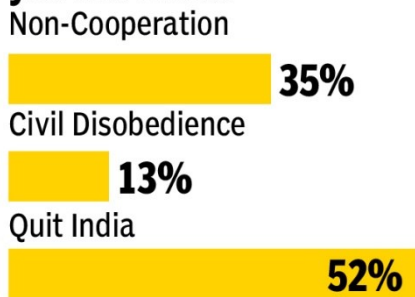

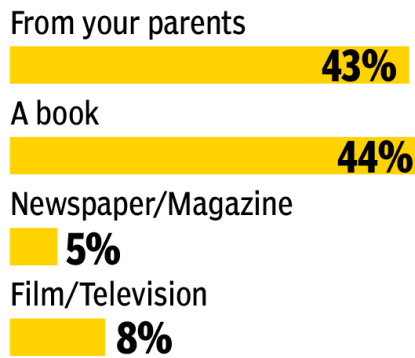


This bicycle is on display at Sabarmati Ashram

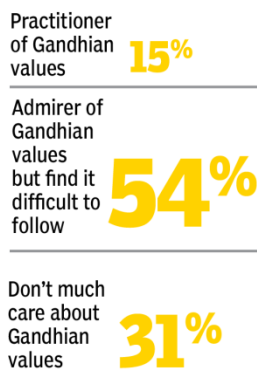
