FSSAI in collaboration with Global Food Safety Partnership (GFSP) is organizing training workshop on detection of Mycotoxins in Singapore from 8.01.2019 to 10.01.2019 to train master trainer.

2. This pilot training will help to create a set of master trainers in the country who in turn will further deliver training to food testing personnel. The training is to provide the participants with the skills and know-how for the detection Aflatoxins B & G in nuts and cereals. The participants will also be trained in advance instrumental techniques and be given the opportunity to operate the HPLC and LC MS/MS instruments to analyze and detect the toxins at sub ppb levels.

3. This training program is only open for **FSSAI notified labs and State Government labs**. The candidates selected from private notified food laboratories will bear their own travel expenses. The TA/DA for the Government employees will be borne by FSSAI and GFSP as per entitlement in their respective organizations.

In this regard, Notified Laboratories and State Food Laboratories are requested to send nomination of one analyst, who is involved in the detection of Mycotoxins, in the prescribed application form (copy enclosed) at training.qa@fssai.gov.in by **28th November, 2018 (4:00 PM)**. The candidates selected by FSSAI will be informed latest by 7th December, 2018
